

BRADNINCH TOWN COUNCIL
REPRESENTATIVE ON THE TOWN TRUST - VACANCY

THE BRADNINCH TOWN TRUST IS MADE UP OF NINE TRUSTEES, FOUR OF WHOM ARE APPOINTED BY THE TOWN COUNCIL. ONE OF THESE FOUR POSITIONS IS NOW VACANT AND THE TOWN COUNCIL IS LOOKING TO APPOINT TO THIS VOLUNTARY POST. THE ROLE, AS A COUNCIL REPRESENTATIVE, IS TO WORK INFORMALLY BETWEEN THE TWO BODIES, INCLUDING REPORTING BACK TO THE TOWN COUNCIL ON RELEVANT MATTERS ARISING AND INFORMING THE TOWN TRUST OF THE WORK AND PLANS OF THE COUNCIL AS RELEVANT.
